Photo Album

Imagine that you have just taken a journey to the setting of your book (this may involve time travel). You visited the places in the book, witnessed the events, and met the characters. While you were there, you snapped pictures the entire time, like a photojournalist trying to capture every detail. Now you've returned home and you need to sort through all of your photos. You will choose the four most important photos.

The four photos should show what you believe are the most important aspects of your book. You will then draw the four photos. You may need to do some research to find out what types of clothes were worn, what the landscape looked like, and so on. You may use your book as a reference.

For each photo, you must write a caption that is at least one to three sentences long. In the caption, explain why the image in the photo is so important in the book. Finally, mount the photos and captions in a construction paper album.

This to do:

- I. Draw the four most important pictures that capture every detail based on the book you just read.
- 2. Write one (grades k-2) to three (grades 3-5) sentences about each picture.
- 3. Mount the pictures on a construction paper.
